The meeting was called to order by Yvonne Kind. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Kind read Anderson's request for approval of the following appointees to assist faculty committees:

Wohlgenant motioned that the above appointees be approved by Central Board. McKown seconded the motion. Carried.

Kind read LeRoy Heinz' request for the approval of Central Board of a play to be put on by the Drama Dept. Oct. 20. The play can be handled by the present Drama Dept. budget according to Heinz, and the date does not conflict with any other activity. This play is organized by the University of Minnesota Lecture and Concert Bureau and consists of a group of graduates of midwestern colleges, and the play would have a one night stand. Wohlgenant suggested that the Budget and Finance committee investigate the matter before further action by Central Board be taken.

It was decided that Central Board would have its regular meetings every Tuesday at 5 P.M. this year.

Kind read Anderson's request for the power to appoint Store Board members until an election can be held at the first possible date since only 2 members of those elected last spring have returned. Those he asked to be appointed are Bob Holding, Peg Griffith, Jack Lepley. In order to grant such power it was necessary to consider passage of a by-law to the ASMSU constitution. Murphy moved that a by-law be added to the constitution in reference to Article VII, Sec. 10 to the effect that the president of ASMSU be empowered to appoint persons to elective committees until such time as an election can be held to fill any vacancies upon approval of Central Board. Wohlgenant seconded the motion and the motion carried. McKown then moved that Central Board approve the above mentioned appointees for appointment to Store Board until such time as an election can be held. Kugler seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Don Graff brought up the fact that the Kaimen needs 3 associate editors. It was decided to begin advertisement for these editors immediately.

Monroe DeJornett was present to recommend that Central Board set the price for the Community Concert tickets so that the advertising campaign might be started at once. McKown moved that \$1.75 be charged for Community Concert season tickets. The price for individual concert tickets would be set later by Central Board. It was decided instead, that action be delayed until the matter could be taken up by Budget and Finance.

ASMSU made \$35.68 on the Freshman mixer last Friday, Sept. 22. The meeting was then adjourned.
