## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Dean Robert E. Sullivan of the Montana State University Law School has been appointed to a number of committees of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws by Walter Malcolm, Boston, Mass., conference president.

The dean was named chairman of the Committee on Compacts and Agreements between States, which is cooperating with a liaison committee representing a number of industrial associations in the drafting of a Traffic Safety Compact. It is hoped that this compact will be ready for submission to state legislatures in 1967.

He will also serve as chairman of Section D, one of eight sections of the conference. Section D includes seven drafting committees working on subject matter in the fields of Uniform Divorce and Marriage Laws through Uniform Juvenile Court Acts.

Dean Sullivan's other appointments are to the Special Committee on Uniform Estate Tax Apportionment Act and Uniform Death Tax Credit Act, the Committee on Law School Research, and the Committee to Review Conference Acts. He will also be liaison member for the State of Montana to the Legislative Committee.
