SPEAKS AT UM THURSDAY NIGHT

Anthony Burgess, author of the best-selling novel, "A Clockwork Orange," will present a free public lecture at 8 o'clock tonight (Thursday) in the University Center Ballroom at the University of Montana.

The program, entitled "An Evening with Anthony Burgess," is sponsored by the Program Council of the Associated Students of UM.

Burgess, who is a writer and consultant for the Guthrie Theater in Minneapolis, Minn., has written 16 novels and eight works of nonfiction over the past 16 years. His latest novel is "The Clockwork Testament or In Derby's End."
