GERMAN FILM TO BE SHOWN TUESDAY AT UM

MISSOULA--

A German film entitled "Taetowierung" (pronounced Tatovierung), a 1967 color movie exemplifying the relationships between various personalities within a group environment, will be shown free of charge Tuesday, April 15, at the University of Montana under the sponsorship of the German section of the UM Department of Foreign Languages. The film, in German with English subtitles, will be presented at 7:30 p.m. in room 102 of the UM Liberal Arts Building.

Dr. Dennis R. McCormick, assistant professor of foreign languages at UM, who is in charge of the film presentation, said the movie involves a boy who shoots his adopted father after being transferred from an orphanage to the home of his new foster parents. In the liberal atmosphere of a middle-class family, the boy is unable to find a replacement for his embedded childhood group instincts.
