CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES
November 1, 1949

The meeting was called to order by John Holding. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Bergh presented the following recommendations from Publications Board:

- 1/ that Rolf Harmsen and Bud Booth be allowed to distribute blotters on campus on the condition that the enterprise be strictly private with no recommendation from the University, Publications Board or Central Board, and that Andy Cogswell, (Director, Public Service Division) give his permission.

Hennessy moved that Central Board accept the above recommendation.

Bergh seconded the motion. Carried.

- 2/ that permission be granted Harold McLoughlin and his associates to distribute on campus an unofficial publication called the Montana Sportsweek, without advertising, supported by subscriptions.

Fox moved that Central Board accept the above recommendation.

Hennessy seconded the motion. Carried.

Hennessy received permission to send 100 tickets to Freddie Slack to Missoula County High School.

Holding requested \$10 for gas and food expenses incurred by a committee which went to Butte to make arrangements in regard to the Butte game.

Fox moved that Central Board reimburse Holding \$10 to pay for the trip to Butte to make arrangements in regard to the Butte game.

Hennessy seconded the motion. Carried.

Freeman presented the following recommendation from the Budget and Finance Committee:

that 100 new band uniforms be purchased, with cost not exceeding \$50. per uniform; and that the expenditure be authorized from the Reserve for Capital Expenditures; and further, that Central Board reserve the right to make the final selection of the type and cost of the uniforms.

Bergh moved that Central Board accept the above recommendation. Fox seconded the motion. Carried.

Motion by Briggs, seconded by Fox, that a letter of appreciation be sent to the joint alumni committee which sponsored the student dance after the Butte game. Carried.

A seconded special junior class meeting to elect a junior delegate to Central Board will be held Wednesday, November 9 at 7:30 in the Student Union auditorium. Central Board will count ballots.

The meeting was then adjourned.
