MISSOULA--

A special seminar on innovations for teaching elementary school mathematics, scheduled for Monday and Tuesday, July 14-15, in Missoula under the sponsorship of the University of Montana Center for Continuing Education and Summer Programs (CCESP), has been canceled because of the teacher's ill health.

Dora Whittaker, a former teacher from England who has been working as a teachers' consultant on the island of Malta, was to have taught the course, Education 594, "Comparative Curricula: Activities and Innovations for Teaching Elementary School Mathematics," but she has returned to England for health reasons. The Missoula seminar had been scheduled for Lewis and Clark School.
