The fall quarter art enrichment program for children and young adults from age 3 to 18 will be conducted at the University of Montana in Missoula beginning Saturday, Oct. 18. Classes will be from 9:30-11:30 a.m. on six Saturdays in the UM Fine Arts Building.

Areas to be explored will include drawing, painting, sculpture, creative writing, photography, film making, body movement, music and ceramics.

Cost of each session will be 75 cents per participant.
