Mr. and Mrs. Herbert M. "Hub" White, Los Altos, Calif., have donated \$500 to the University of Montana Alumni Association for campus programs.

White received the bachelor of arts degree in journalism in 1925 at UM, and Mrs. White, the former Ruth Bryson Baker, was awarded the bachelor of arts degree in business administration at UM the same year. Both are in Missoula for the 50th anniversary reunion of the UM Class of '25 during UM Homecoming activities Friday and Saturday.

A reception honoring the Grizzly reunion classes of 1925, 1940 and 1950 will be at 4 p.m. Friday, Oct. 17, at the Florence Motor Inn.

White, who retired in 1965 from the staff of Montana State University, Bozeman, served 30 years at MSU as assistant director of information and assistant Extension Service editor. He previously was in newspaper work in Great Falls, Billings and Havre.

M. Catherine White, "Hub" White's sister, was ^amember of the UM Library staff for about 30 years. She is now retired and lives at 439 University Ave., Missoula. She is author of the book entitled "Journals of David Thompson," published in 1950 by the University Press.
