CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES

October 19, 1948

The meeting was opened in due form. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mueller reported that Mrs. Hazelbaker wants Central Board's opinion on having A.S.M.S.U. contribute to the Crippled Children's fund rather than to give a dance to raise the money. It was decided that the student body would not give a dance for this purpose but that if the Crippled Children's association wanted to give a dance here they could.

Lucas reported that we could purchase a Kimbal piano at Hefte's for \$550. We could also buy rollers and a water-proof case there. It was decided that we should delay purchasing such a piano in hopes that the University would buy it for us.

Mueller reported that various unauthorized activities such as giving away programs at the games and chartering a bus have been in competition with student associations. After much debate, Freeman moved that Publications Board be asked to submit a bi-law to the constitution controlling all unauthorized soliciting and distributing of publications, circulars, and handbills in competition with student activities. The motion passed.

Lemire asked for Central Board's approval of the 1949 Sentinel budget. This budget included an increase of \$60 a year more for the photography editor and also the recommendation that surplus funds from the 1948 Sentinel be put into an emergency fund for the 1949 Sentinel. Freeman moved that we accept this budget, Morrison seconded the motion and the motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned.
