CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES  
November 9, 1948

The meeting was called to order by the president and the minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Lucas recommended that the piano which Crowder had suggested that we buy from Hefte's Music for \$530, be purchased by A.S.M.S.U. and the money drawn from the general fund. McCleod seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Bob Zibell from the International Relations Club asked Central Board if they would approve of an allotment of \$80 to pay for the registration fees and lodging and insurance expenditures for five delegates to attend the Pacific Coast Conference. This \$80 would include \$35 registration fee and \$45 for lodging and insurance. Lucas made the motion that Central Board allot \$80 for International Relations Club to send five delegates to the Pacific Coast Conference with the stipulation that if it is at all possible they give a convo, thus giving the student body the benefits of their experiences at this conference. Shallenberger seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

The meeting was then adjourned.
