Entries for the 59th Foresters Ball queen competition at the University of Montana will be accepted until noon Thursday, Dec. 4. Any campus organization or living group, such as a dormitory, sorority, fraternity or club, may sponsor a queen candidate.

Information about each candidate should include name, major, year, areas of interest, the sponsoring organization and a snapshot. Each candidate must be currently enrolled and at the University /hold a grade point average of 2.00 (C) or better. Queen candidates' names and pertinent information may be deposited in the Forestry Students' Association (FSA) mailbox on the first floor of the UM Forestry Building.

Candidates will be interviewed by a committee of foresters and the 58th Foresters'
Ball Queen, Patricia Ann Boyle, <u>Great Falls</u>, a junior at UM. Interviews will take place in
Room 201 in the Forestry School at 7 p.m. Monday, Dec. 8. Five finalists will be chosen
from responses to questions based on general interest. Names of the finalists will be
announced Tuesday, Dec. 9.

The queen will be selected by closed ballot of UM forestry students. Names of the Queen and four runners-up will be announced at the Forsters Week Convocation Jan. 12 in the University Theater, where the queen, with the four runners-up serving as princesses, will begin a one-week reign.

The 59th Foresters Ball will be Jan. 16-17 in the UM Men's Gym.

Profits from the ball provide loans and scholarships for UM forestry students through the UM Forestry Students Association. Loans, available to UM forestry students who assist in putting on the ball, are interest free. Scholarships range in value from \$50 to \$200.
