'YELLOWSTONE ELK CONTROVERSY' IS TOPIC
OF THURSDAY DISCUSSION BY PENGELLY

MISSOULA--

Dr. W. Leslie Pengelly, a professor of forestry at the University of Montana, who is affiliated with the UM Wildlife Biology Department, will discuss "The Yellowstone Elk Controversy in Yellowstone National Park" Thursday at UM.

Thursday's free public discussion will be at 8 p.m. in the UM Music Recital Hall to accommodate more persons than previously expected. The lecture originally was scheduled to be held in the University Center Lounge.

Pengelly's lecture will focus on the deaths of 1,500 elk in Yellowstone Park last winter and the need for elk management in the park.
