ALPHA LAMBDA DELTA OFFERS 10 FELLOWSHIPS

MISSOULA--

Women students at the University of Montana who are seniors now and who were elected to membership in Alpha Lambda Delta (ALD), freshman women's national scholastic honorary, are eligible to apply for 10 fellowships for graduate study being offered by ALD. Women who were seniors at UM last year and who were elected to ALD as freshmen also are eligible to apply for the fellowships.

Fellowships to be awarded by ALD include the Maria Leonard, Alice Crocker Lloyd, and Adele Hagner Stamp Fellowships; the Kathryn Sisson Phillips, Christine Yerges Conaway, and May Augusta Brunson Fellowships; and the 50th Anniversary Miriam A. Shelden Fellowship and Gladys Pennington Houser Fellowship. Also included are the Bicentennial Fellowship and the International Women's Year Fellowship.

Any member of Alpha Lambda Delta who graduated with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5 (B-plus) is eligible to apply. Graduating seniors may apply if they have achieved this average to the end of the first semester or first quarter of the 1975-76 academic year.

Applicants will be judged on scholastic record, recommendations, the soundness of their stated project and purpose, and need. The amount of each fellowship is \$2,000. Attendance at a graduate school on a campus where there is a chapter of ALD is encouraged.

Each application form must be completed by the applicant herself and submitted to National Alpha Lambda Delta, Box 279, Lewisburg, Pa. 17837, by Jan. 6, 1976.
