MISSOULA--

The Safety and Security Division of the University of Montana Physical Plant Department is curtailing use of campus buildings during the holiday period in order to reduce heating costs during hours of low occupancy and to minimize the chances of theft and vandalism.

Campus buildings will be open generally from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays. Buildings will be closed on weekends and on Christmas Day and New Year's Day. The reduced-use schedule continues through Sunday, Jan. 4.

Besides reducing the possibilities of theft and vandalism, closing buildings during hours of low occupancy will permit thermostats to be set at 65 degrees, resulting in savings in heating costs.

Campus departments wishing to schedule building usage when the buildings are not open should coordinate their requests with the UM Physical Plant Department's Safety and Security Division.
