7,739 STUDENTS
REPRESENT 6% GAIN
AT U OF MONTANA

MISSOULA--

A total of 7,739 students are enrolled for winter quarter at the University of Montana, the office of Registrar Wayne C. Woolston reported Thursday.

The gross enrollment figure of 7,739--representing a machine-tabulated count through Wednesday (Jan. 13)--is an increase of 444 students, a gain of 6 per cent compared with the gross enrollment of 7,295 a year ago.

Autumn quarter enrollment last fall was 8,393, a net figure which excludes the students who dropped out of school between the beginning and end of the quarter.

Of this year's winter quarter enrollment, 5,095 are men and 2,644 are women.
