### 10 UM GRADUATES PASS NATIONAL CPA EXAMINATIONS

The results of the National Certified Public Accountants' Examinations given in November 1970 have just been announced by Dr. Jack J. Kempner, chairman of the School of Business Administration's Department of Accounting and Finance at the University of Montana.
