The University of Montana baseball team travels to Bozeman Saturday for a

doubleheader with Montana State University, coach Lem Elway said Thursday.

The Grizzly-Bobcat diamond clash opens the Big Sky play for Montana. The Tips are 8-10 on the season and have a five game winning streak going.

Elway said he would start Mike Potter in the opener. Potter was thought to be lost for the season with a dislocated shoulder but was pronounced ready for action Thursday. He is 1-1 on the season with a 5.73 ERA.

In the second contest the starter will be either Kendall Kallevig, Gary Smith or Bob Hayes. Randy Smith and Mark Elway will be in relief.

Elway said left fielder Larry Slocum quit because of recurring leg soreness. Mike Mikota will take Slocum's place in left.

Behind the plate for Montana will be Gary Kenney while the rest of the infield finds Dale Phillips, first; Don Wetzel, second; Kirk Johnson, shortstop and Bob Rutledge, third.

Rounding out the outfield for the Grizzlies finds Mikota, left; Tom Bertleson, center and Marty Frustaci, right.

The Grizzlies return home for a doubleheader with Western Montana, Tuesday.
