Applications for the Montana High School Fine Arts Camp Aug. 1-13 on the University of Montana campus are still being accepted, according to Donald A. Carey, camp director and an assistant professor of music at UM.

Courses of study offered during the camp will include band, orchestra, chorus, art, dance, allied arts, conducting, dance band, piano workshop, drama and chamber music.

Private lessons also will be offered, as well as classes in music literature, music theory, piano ensemble and theater workshop.

Guest artists teaching during the camp session include Oscar Stover, Northwest Oklahoma State University, who will conduct the camp band, and Zaben Melikian, assistant concert master of the San Francisco Symphony, who will conduct the camp orchestra.

The Atlanta String Quartet will supervise chamber music ensembles during the two-week camp and Dr. Joseph Mussulman, an associate professor of music at UM, will direct the camp chorus.
