CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES  
OCTOBER 15, 1946

The meeting was called to order by the president, Jerry Anderson, and the minutes of the October 8 and October 14 meetings were read and corrections were made.

Anderson appointed Tannisse Brown, Jo Ann Blair, and Don Kern to see if the Ski Club was still interested in presenting Bob Crosby's orchestra.

Riven reported that Mr. Swearingen had a temporary score board built but that the students would have to paint it. Miller will take charge of painting it and Riven will see Mr. Swearingen about the cost.

Golder suggested that a member of the band should be on Traditions Board so Central Board appointed Daniel McKeel, president of the band, as an ex-officio member of this board.

Mr. Gray, director of the band, asked Central Board for an appropriation of \$249.50 for the difference in tickets for the Butte trip as the special transportation rates on which the budget was based are not available this year. He also asked for appropriations out of the reserve fund for band instruments. It was suggested that he refer this to the Budget and Finance Committee for a revision of the budget based on the present enrollment.

Phil McGee, representing the a capella choir, asked Central Board for an appropriation of \$950. for 60 choir robes. It was suggested that he see President McCain about the university financing the purchase of these robes.

A representative from the orchestra asked for an appropriation of \$500 for the purchase of two French Horns which could be used by both the band and orchestra. He was told to see the Budget and Finance Committee about the appropriation.

Anderson appointed the following committee to handle the Freshman elections on October 30; Don Kern, Jo Ann Blair, Mary Morrow, and Peg Hanley. Petitions for the offices of President, Vice-president, Secretary, Treasurer, and Delegate to Central Board must be turned in to Kirk Badgely with 20 signatures beside the candidate's by Saturday noon, October 26.

The meeting adjourned.
