The meeting was called to order by Jerry Anderson, president of ASMSU.

President McCain stated that the University would like to buy the golf course from the student body because it is now the site of one of University's housing projects and they feel that housing is a problem of the university and not a student one. They also / stated that if it was property of the University it would be exempt from taxation.

After much discussion, no action on this proposal was taken until further investigation in to the matter by Central Board and Store Board. Anderson said he would contact Mr. Fritz, president of the Alumni Challenge Athletic Field Corporation, to find out when he can meet with the two boards because the Corporation holds ^{the} title to the golf course.

McCain stated that the University is willing to introduce a bill before the Legislature to have the state purchase this land if the students want it.

The meeting adjourned.
