David Crow, planning director for the Missoula City-County Planning Board, will discuss "Problems of Implementing the Missoula Comprehensive Development Plan" at noon Friday (Nov. 5) in room 307 of the University of Montana's Natural Science Building.

After a brief introductory statement, Crow will answer questions about the relationship of the Missoula Comprehensive Development Plan to specific areas such as Hughes Gardens east of Missoula.
