MISSOULA--

When the University of Montana Grizzlies trot onto the University of Hawaii football field for Saturday night's game they will see two familiar faces -- Hawaii's Elroy Chong and Yasuo Yorita, both of whom played for Montana last year.

Neither Chong, a quarterback, nor Yorita, a receiver and defensive back, are starting for the Rainbows this year, but chances are they both will see at least some action during the game. Chong started one game, against Los Angeles State, and has been relieving regular quarterback Mike Biscotti off and on all season.

Chong also played an alternate with Montana last year. He returned to Hawaii because he couldn't break into the starting lineup here and because he likes to throw the ball -- a rare occurrence with the "Wishbone" offense.

Before last weekend, Chong had completed 28 of 66 passes for 408 yards and four touchdowns. At Montana last year he completed six of 16 for 83 yards and one touchdown.

Yorita didn't play often with the Grizzlies last year, but has been playing a lot with Hawaii the past three games. The Rainbows have him helping out in the defensive backfield and returning punts. Both Chong and Yorita are natives of Honolulu.

The Grizzlies leave Missoula Friday for the Saturday game.
