FOUR UM FACULTY MEMBERS
APPOINTED TO AACTE

MISSOULA--

Four University of Montana faculty members recently were appointed institutional representatives by the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education (AACTE), according to Dr. J. Francis Rummel, dean of the UM School of Education and liaison officer for the association.

The faculty members are Dr. Robert H. Jay, associate professor of education and director of student teaching; Dr. Thomas Payne, professor of political science; Dr. James W. Cox, associate professor of chemistry and education, and Dr. Walter Brown, professor of English.

Dr. Rummel said the four men will serve as "key communication links" between University personnel engaged in teaching preparation programs and the AACTE.
