FREE FORESTRY EXHIBIT
SUNDAY-FRIDAY AT UM

MISSOULA--

An exhibit of forestry products and a miniature sky-line logging system will be featured Sunday through Friday by University of Montana forestry students.

The public display, from noon-5 p.m. Sunday and 8 a.m.-5 p.m. each weekday in the University Center 361-series rooms, is being held in conjunction with the 55th annual UM Foresters' Convocation Nov. 29 and Foresters' Ball Dec. 3-4 in the Harry Adams Field House.

The exhibits will include a silver iodide generator used by the U.S. Forest Service to prevent lightning. Also scheduled are slide shows explaining silvicultural or tree-improvement processes and a new concept in forestry landscape architecture.

Exhibit sponsors include the Anaconda Co., Hoerner Waldorf Corporation and Evans Products Co. of Missoula and the Smith-Berger Co. of Seattle, Wash.

Tickets for the UM Foresters' Ball will be on sale at the University Center during the week.
