CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES

May 9, 1945

The meeting was called to order by the president and the minutes of the May 1 meeting were read and approved.

Jean Richards spoke on behalf of the Student Betterments Committee and offered the following suggestions:

1. That Central Board underwrite \$22 for the purchase of subscriptions to one copy of the New York Times, two copies of the Great Falls Tribune, and one copy of the Daily Missoulian to be placed in the Student Union lounge for student reading.

2. That Central Board help sponsor a student-faculty picnic to take the place of one of the regular coffee hours.

3. That Central Board provide for a bottle of ink to be placed in the reading room of the library.

4. That the tennis courts be repaired.

MacKenzie moved that Central Board recommend to the Student Union Committee that they purchase one-quarter subscriptions to the following newspapers for the Student Union lounge: one copy of the New York Times, two copies of the Great Falls Tribune, and one copy of the Daily Missoulian. Floyd seconded and the motion passed.

There will be a banquet for old and new members of Central Board at the Palace, Tuesday, May 15, at 6:30 o'clock. The wives of faculty members of the board are invited. The two presidents will speak at the banquet.

The 1945-46 Associated Students Budget was submitted to Central Board for approval by Jeannette Bakke, Chairman of the Budget and Finance Committee. Floyd moved that Central Board approve the budget for 1945-46 as submitted by the Budget and Finance Committee. Kerr seconded and the motion passed.

It was suggested by the Kaimin editor that the time of Central Board meeting be changed in order to facilitate the publication of Central Board news in the Kaimin.

Welsh and Switzer suggested that Central Board sponsor some entertainment for the high school students who would be visiting here during the trackmeet sponsored by the Jay Cees. Because of an agreement between Dr. Melby and Dr. Renne of Bozeman, Central Board is unable to sponsor any entertainment for the high school students. There will be a convocation Friday, however, to which high school students will be invited, and the Spurs will sponsor a jitney dance Saturday after the songfest sponsored by the Newman Club.
