CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES
May 23, 1944

Meeting was called to order by the president and the minutes for the May 16, 1944 meeting were dispensed with.


Lorraine Griffith talked to the board about the Sentinel and of financing a photographic or darkroom for the staff. The old room in the Journalism Building is to be remodeled next year possibly with a special room for the Sentinel. About \$200 is needed for this change. They want to have the office centrally located in order to lessen the confusion. The whole matter will be discussed in the fall, as well as whether or not there will be a Sentinel next year.

Bakke moved that Central Board hold over the matter of putting aside the funds for a dark room for the Sentinel until next year. Sackett seconded and the motion carried.

The question of Publications Board also is to be carried over until next year when the matter of membership can be looked up in the by-laws, which were passed last fall (1943). All other committees were approved.

The Kaimin will be published twice a week next year. Kinkade moved that Central Board back two issues of the Kaimin a week next year. Bakke seconded and the motion carried.

Meeting adjourned.
