HESS TO DISCUSS 'COMMUNICATIONS'

Philip J. Hess, chairman of the University of Montana Department of Radio and Television, will discuss "Communications--The Integrator of Multidisciplinary Studies" at the University on Thursday (Aug. 2) during the UM Short Course in Land Use Planning.
