Junior halfback Ken Williams, a spring transfer from Citrus College (Azusa, Calif.), made his first appearance at the University of Montana's fall football camp Tuesday morning.

UM coach Jack Swarthout said that Williams reported late because of "personal problems." Williams arrived in Missoula from his hometown of Houston, Texas, Monday night.

The 5-6, 155-pounder is known for his quickness and break-away running ability. He received Junior College All-America recognition at Citrus on the strength of his 1399 yards rushing in 10 games and his kickoff and punt returning.

Swarthout said that Williams will have to work at getting in shape, learning plays and developing the fundamental timing that the other UM backs have achieved in the first eight days of drills.
