JERRY WAYNE SCHUSTER AWARDED
\$1,000 E. E. BENNETT SCHOLARSHIP

MISSOULA--

Jerry Wayne Schuster, a senior history and political science major at the University of Montana, Missoula, has been named recipient of a \$1,000 scholarship for the 1973-74 academic year. The award was made through the Edward Earl Bennett Memorial Scholarship Fund at UM.

Schuster, 21, is a 1970 graduate of Billings West High School. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank J. Schuster, 3518 Powderhorn Circle, Billings.

Schuster, who has a 3.83 cumulative grade point average, was listed as a straight-A student on the University's spring quarter honor roll.

Announcement of the award to Schuster was made by Dr. John E. Van de Wetering, chairman of the UM history department. He was chosen recipient by a UM faculty committee.

The Edward Earl Bennett Memorial Scholarship Fund was created in 1971 with a \$20,000 grant by the late Dr. Bennett's son, Harold Bennett of China Lake, Calif. The elder Bennett was a member of the UM history department for 33 years.

The scholarship is awarded annually to the outstanding senior in history or political science at UM on the basis of general excellence in either field without regard to need. The selection is made without regard to race, creed, color or sex.

Jody Marie Vredenburg, Fortune, was the 1972 recipient.
