FOUR UM STUDENTS RECEIVE
AFROTC SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA--

Four University of Montana students have been awarded Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) scholarships for the coming academic year.

The recipients are: Steven D. Haff, a freshman from Santa Clara, Calif.; Neal D. Lutke, a junior from Missoula; Brent B. Mathiew, a freshman from Sidney, and Mark F. Meyer, a junior from Rapid City, S.D.

The scholarships consist of a tax-free allowance of \$100 a month and full payment of tuition, books, laboratory and associated fees. Because the four UM students are pilot qualified, they will receive 36 hours of free flying lessons during their senior year at UM.

Each year 6,500 Air Force ROTC cadets are awarded full scholarships on the basis of academic and leadership abilities.
