GOLDEN GRIZZLY, DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS
TO BE PRESENTED AT ALUMNI LUNCHEON FRIDAY

MISSOULA--

University of Montana alumni from the class of 1923 will be initiated into the Golden Grizzly Den and four UM alumni will receive the UM Alumni Association's Distinguished Service Award (DSA) at the 1973 UM Homecoming awards luncheon at noon Friday (Oct. 12) in the University Center Ballroom.

UM President Robert T. Pantzer will present certificates to the Golden Grizzly Den alumni at the luncheon.

Maurice R. Colberg Jr., a Billings lawyer and 1957 UM alumnus, will present the DSA to William A. Barbour, Moorestown, N.J., president of Chilton Publishing Co.; Joseph H. Fitzgerald, Lindbergh Lake, Mont., federal commissioner for the federal-state land use commission of Alaska, and Edwin T. Mertz, Lafayette, Ind., a biochemist at Purdue University. Because of illness, Reynold C. Fuson, Reno, Nev., professor of organic chemistry at the University of Nevada, will receive the DSA in absentia.

The UM singing Jubileers, under the direction of Dr. Joseph A. Mussulman, UM music professor, will entertain at the luncheon.

UM alumni from the classes of 1923, 1938 and 1948 will participate in a class reunion at 4 p.m. Friday at the UM Alumni Center.

Homecoming registration for UM alumni will be Friday afternoon at the Elks Club and from 8 a.m.-8 p.m. Friday at the Alumni Center on campus. Alumni also may register during a coffee hour at the Alumni Center from 9 a.m. to noon Saturday.
