An art exhibit by four North Dakota printmakers--Martin, Piehl, Schaefer, and Schweiger--will be presented in the University of Montana Gallery of Visual Arts from Nov. 5-16.

Dean Douglas, UM art instructor and gallery director, said the exhibit consists of 35 prints. Etching and lithography, traditional methods of printmaking, as well as new techniques such as prints made from earth, will be included in the display.
