Final rounds of the third annual All-Indian High School Speech Meet will be held Friday (Nov. 16) in the University Center at the University of Montana.

Robert J. Swan, assistant director and adviser for the UM Indian Studies Program, who is tournament adviser, said the third round of debate will be from 8-10 a.m. and the second round of individual events will be from 1-4 p.m. Final rounds of the tournament will be from 4-5:30 p.m. All competitive events take place in the UC Montana Rooms.

The tournament awards banquet will begin at 6:30 p.m. Friday in the UC Gold Oak Room.

Swan said a total of 70 students from 12 communities are participating in the speech meet, which is sponsored by the UM Kyi-Yo Indian Club.

Tournament participants are from Arlee, Ashland, Box Elder, Browning, Busby, Frazer, Lodge Grass, Polson, Ronan, St. Ignatius, Valier and Wolf Point.
