

CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES
Oct. 31, 1944

The meeting was called to order by the president. In the absence of the secretary, the minutes of the previous meeting were dispensed with.

Central Board representatives to the Freshmen class elections are to be Harriet Dillavou, Jeannette Bakke, and Lew Burdick.

Since the ballots for the election of A.S.M.S.U. Vice-President are to be printed, it was decided that a 1,000 ballot sheets would be made.

Means of checking on the A.S.T.R.P. students before allowing them to cast their vote were discussed. It was decided that each cadet must present his activity card before being given a ballot.


The A.S.M.S.U. election will be held Thursday, Nov. 2, between the hours of 1 and 6. Schedule for the voting table is as follows:

Bakke seconded and the motion was carried.
