It will be Family Night and Girls' Basketball Night when the University of Montana Grizzlies host Portland State University Friday night.

The Family Night promotion means the entire family (maximum of two adults and six children) will be admitted to the Grizzly-Viking game for a flat fee. Mom, Dad and all the kids can have general admission seating for \$3 or reserved seats for \$4. In addition, children of season ticket holders and Century Club members will be admitted free to the game.

UM Ticket Manager Gary Hughes said the family tickets for reserved seats are now on sale at the Fieldhouse, but that the general admission tickets will only be sold on game day.

The University is also inviting the girls' basketball teams from Western Montana high schools to be its guests at the game. Through Thursday 12 teams, with a representation of over 230 girls, had reserved tickets.
