A life member of the University Alumni Association and president of Missoula's First National Bank, Theodore Jacobs, will be grand marshal of the 1965 University of Montana Homecoming parade Saturday morning.

Eleven bands comprising 709 musicians will march representing the University and high schools in Butte, Dillon, Helena, Missoula, Ronan, St. Ignatius, Polson, Hamilton and Anaconda. Parade floats will be built on the theme, "A Night in Las Vegas."

Parade Marshal Jacobs received his bachelor of laws degree from the University in 1935 and has been a member of the University Executive Board for more than 20 years. His wife, the former Olive Smith, was graduated with a bachelor of arts degree in education in 1935.
