The University Center and Campus Recreation Department at the University of Montana and the U.S. Forest Service will cosponsor a one-day avalanche seminar Feb. 3 at Big

Mountain near Whitefish. The program is open to the public.

Pre-seminar classes will be held at 7 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday (Jan. 30-31) in the 360 series rooms of the University Center.

Classes will cover aspects of avalanche control and safety along with winter travel techniques. Class and seminar size will be limited to 12.

Participants will leave from the Adams Field House at UM for Big Mountain at 7 a.m. Feb. 3.

Course instructor will be Cal Tassinari of the U.S. Forest Service.
