The University of Montana women's basketball team raised its season record to 7-3 last weekend by winning two of three games at Kalispell.

Montana defeated Gonzaga University 75-16 and Carroll College 93-29. UM was upset by a hot shooting Flathead Valley Community College team 64-49. Leading UM scorers for the Gonzaga contest were Vicki Brown, 26, Michelle Peck, 20 and Chris Mahoney, 19. Against Carroll, Montana had four players in double figures. Chris Mahoney led the way with 35 points, Peck had 30, Brown 19, and Janele Sullivan 11. Mahoney poured in 25 points against FVCC to finish with a three-game total of 79.
