WILDERNESS SOCIETY PRESIDENT TO SPEAK
FRIDAY (MARCH 9) IN SEMINAR SERIES

MISSOULA--

Doris Milner, Hamilton, president of the Montana Wilderness Society, will be the final speaker in the winter quarter environmental seminar series sponsored by the University of Montana botany department.

Ms. Milner will discuss "Conservation and a New Land Ethic" at 12:10p.m. Friday (March 9) in room 307 of the UM Natural Science Building. The program is open to the public without charge.

Dr. Meyer Chessin, UM botany professor and seminar coordinator, said Ms. Milner has been active in the establishment and enlargement of regional wilderness areas.

"She is particularly knowledgeable about the Magruder Corridor and Bitterroot National Forest timber management controversies," Chessin said.
