KATHERINE WEIST OF UM
RECEIVES POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

MISSOULA--

Dr. Katherine M. Weist, assistant professor of anthropology at the University of Montana, Missoula, has received a one-year post-doctoral fellowship to conduct Indian research at the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D.C.

Weist received the National Endowment for the Humanities Fellowship in Historical, Social and Cultural Studies of U.S. Ethnic Minorities, enabling her to go to the Smithsonian Institution this fall, where she will do research on the history of Montana Indians. She will gather data from the National Archives in Washington, D.C.

Weist, who has been at UM since 1969, received her bachelor of science degree in 1958 and her master's degree in 1962 from Ohio State University, Columbus. She received her Ph.D. in anthropology in 1970 from the University of California at Berkeley.
