Late registration for the spring CLEM (Continuing Legal Education in Montana) conference will be conducted from 8:15 to 9 a.m. Friday (April 27), according to Robert E. Sullivan, dean of the University of Montana law school.

The topic of the two-day conference April 27-28 is "Trends in Consumer Credit Legislation." The program, cosponsored by the Montana Bar Association and the UM School of Law, is being held in conjunction with the law school's annual Law Day activities.

Sullivan said the purpose of the conference is to explore the problems of consumer credit in Montana and to explain a bill for comprehensive consumer credit legislation presently before the Montana Legislature.

Late registration will precede regular conference activities in the Five Valleys Room of the University Center. Cost of attending is \$25 per person.
