The University of Montana Jazz Workshop, under the direction of UM music instructor Lance Boyd, will present a free public concert at 8:30 p.m. Friday (May 11) in the University Center Ballroom.

The Program Council of the Associated Students of UM is sponsoring the two-hour performance.

Boyd said works for Friday's program will include "Survival," "Get It On," "Here's That Rainy Day," "Reflections," "Sissy Strut" and "It was a Very Good Year."

John Barker, a University student from Missoula, will be featured as trombone soloist on "Blood, Sweat and Tears Ballad for My Lady."

Marc Wittman, Jazz Workshop drummer from Missoula, will be featured during the work entitled "A Roarin' Borealis."

Both Barker and Wittman are graduates of Missoula Sentinel High School.
