\$4,650 AWARDED IN JOURNALISM  
SCHOLARSHIPS FRIDAY AT UM

MISSOULA--

A total of \$4,650 in scholarships and awards was presented to 24 University of Montana journalism and radio-television students at an awards luncheon Friday.

Warren J. Brier, dean of the UM journalism school, said the awards presented Friday were scheduled to be given at the annual Dean Stone Night banquet May 17, but the banquet was cancelled when the guest speaker could not attend. Sam Donaldson, ABC News Capitol Hill correspondent, could not keep the speaking engagement because of his extensive professional duties in reporting the Watergate investigation for ABC television and radio.
