BACKPACKING COURSE BEGINS JUNE 11; REGISTRATION DEADLINE WEDNESDAY

MISSOULA--

Two one-week courses in backpacking and wilderness camping, sponsored by the 1973 University of Montana Summer Session, will be offered June 11-17 and Aug. 6-12 at UM.

The registration deadline for the first course is Wednesday (June 6). Each session will be limited to 20 persons.

Open to currently enrolled University students, the two-credit course is conducted by the UM Department of Health, Physical Education and Recreation (HPER).

Both registration and \$15 special fee for guide service and transportation can be made through the HPER office, room 201 in the Harry Admas Field House.

The class will consist of three afternoons of classroom instruction, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 2-5 p.m. Wednesday afternoon through Thursday morning there will be an overnight hike and campout. On Friday, the class will hike into a Mission Mountain wilderness area and camp until Sunday.

Participants are required to furnish their own food, sleeping bag and personal gear.
