Central Board Meeting  
October 14, 1941

The meeting was called to order by the President, Marcus Bourke, and the minutes read and approved.

Bourke stated that the faculty has agreed to pay for the coffee hour to be held on Parent's Day and proposed that the student body pay for the cost of labor.

Carr moved that an amount not to exceed six dollars (6.00) be appropriated from the A.S.M. S.U. Operating Fund to pay for labor used in serving during the Coffee Hour following the football game on Parent's Day. Hesser seconded and the motion carried.

The fact-finding committee on raising funds for the Iron Lung Benefit reported that after bringing the matter before various campus organizations, they were unable to get any student support.

Hesser moved that Ross Lemire be appointed Business Manager for the 1942 Sentinel as was recommended by Publications Board. Ryan seconded and the motion was carried.

Ryan moved that Mr. Dugan's appointment to Publications Board as faculty advisor be recommended to the President. Delaney seconded and the motion carried. Due to the absence of the past faculty adviser, Dr. Robert L. Housman, a new appointment was found necessary.

Bourke recommended that the following five students be appointed to A.S.M.S.U. Committees to replace members who did not return to school:

- Publications Board--Loran Foote
- Traditions Board--Marie Murphy
- Rally Committee--Harold Myklebust
- Convocations Committee--Tom Gisborne and Homer Thompson

Hesser moved that the substitutions for committee memberships as above named be approved by Central Board. Ryan seconded and the motion carried.

Jim Haviland, chairman of Homecoming preparations, presented plans to the Board. He suggested that a tag day be given to raise funds for this occasion. Delaney moved that Central Board approve a tag day sale to raise money for Homecoming expenses. Talcott seconded and the motion carried.

Carr presented the budget as was revised for this year, however, no definite action was taken.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
