Central Board Meeting  
October 21, 1941

The meeting was called to order by President Marcus Bourke and the minutes read and approved.

The fact-finding committee on the granting of a bonus to the 1941 Sentinel editor, Walt Millar, presented figures which showed that accounts receivable for the annual total \$382.75. If these accounts are collected there will be a net profit of \$158.85 after the \$90.00 has been paid to Millar.

Ryan moved that Central Board authorize full payment of Walt Millar's bonus from the 1941 Sentinel account after all financial obligations have been fully met and when funds are available. Mudd seconded and the motion carried.

Bourke announced a special meeting of the board on Wednesday, Oct. 23, to discuss the revisions made in the A.S.M.S.U. budget for the present year.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
