UM PROF TO AID MUSIC
TEACHER TRAINING

A University of Montana music professor has begun work to enlist Montana participation in a national program designed to engage future music teachers in the problems of the profession while they are still in training, according to Dean Charles W. Bolen of the School of Fine Arts.
