KATHLEEN DAWN ANDERSON OF BOZEMAN
IS QUEEN OF 59TH FORESTERS' BALL AT UM

MISSOULA--

Kathleen Dawn Anderson, Bozeman, a junior at the University of Montana in Missoula, was named queen of the 59th UM Foresters' Ball Monday night, Jan. 12, at the Foresters' Convocation. She succeeds Patricia Ann Boyle, Great Falls, who was queen of the 58th Foresters' Ball on the Missoula campus.

Anderson, 20, who is majoring in communication sciences and disorders at UM, will reign with her court of four princesses over Foresters' Week activities, which continue through this week. Highlight of the week's activities will be the Foresters' Ball, set from 8 p.m.-1 a.m. Friday, Jan. 16, and from 8 p.m.-midnight Saturday, Jan. 17, in the UM Men's Gym.

Other activities scheduled this week will include Boondockers' Day from 12:15-5 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 14, in the open area near the north side of the UM Forestry Building. Spike Driving, woodsman's competition, pole climbing, railroad tie rolling and a crosscut sawing contest will be included in the Boondockers' Day events.

The election of the queen was by popular vote of UM forestry students. Anderson, who was sponsored in the Foresters' Ball Queen competition by the UM chapter of Alpha Omicron Pi, a social sorority, was among the five UM women students competing for the title.

Anderson is a June 1973 graduate of Holy Rosary High School, Bozeman. She is daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles K. Anderson, 1107 E. Babcock, Bozeman.
