KAYAKING, SKEET SHOOTING COURSES  
SCHEDULED IN SPRING AT UNIVERSITY

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Department of Health, Physical Education and Recreation (HPER) will offer two new activity courses beginning with spring quarter April 1. The new courses are "Whitewater Kayaking," offered under HPER 100, section 52, and "Trap and Skeet," offered under HPER 100, section 53.

Students in "Whitewater Kayaking" will meet from 8-10 a.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Grizzly Pool. Weather permitting, boating sessions on the Clark Fork and Blackfoot Rivers will be scheduled late in the spring. Kayaks and other equipment will be provided. Class size will be limited and permission must be obtained from Dr. Joel F. Meier, HPER chairman at UM, to enroll. His office is in room 201 of the Harry Adams Field House.

Classes in "Trap and Skeet" will meet from 3:30-5:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Missoula trap and skeet range west of town. Shotguns will be furnished and marksmen will assist in the instructions. Mavis Lorenz, associate professor of HPER at UM, has additional information about the "Trap and Skeet" course. Her office is in room 114 of the UM Women's Center.
