October 29, 1940

The meeting was called to order by President Rae Greene. The minutes for the meeting of October 22 were read and approved with the correct spelling of the name of Gayne Moxness.

Badgley reported on how the idea has always prevailed that from the 50¢ student fee Masquers get 45%, Outside Entertainment gets 45%, and 10% is put in the reserve fund to take care of any special feature program that may come up. Masquers are short on equipment so the balance has been allowed to remain in order that they may make purchases. Outside Entertainment Committee has always been instructed to put their balance in the reserve fund at the end of the year. Last year Masquers drew \$366.00 from this reserve fund for the musical show. This reserve fund belongs to Central Board to use as it wishes for any entertainment which has not been scheduled and which the students desire, such as a road show.

Rae asked Derek to see Haydon about drawing up a tentative budget for the musical show, and to ask Haydon and Crowder to attend Central Board at its next meeting.

Derek informed us that Associated students owe delinquent taxes on the McGinnis property next to the location of the bleachers. At the time of the purchase it was believed that all delinquent taxes had been paid. Speer paid them by mistake and wants to be reimbursed for the last half of 1938 and for 1939. Derek wants them to be paid from the Reserve Fund rather than the General Fund. Price moved that \$12.96 be paid from the Reserve Fund for taxes due by Associated Students on the McGinnis property. Kennard seconded it and the motion carried.

Rae received a letter from Thornton W. Allen Co., publishers of college music. Discussion was held about having our Montana songs published. Rae will write the company for additional information and a sample contract.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
